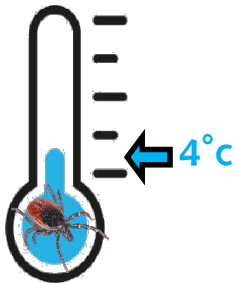

DID YOU KNOW? Ticks are active any time temperatures are 4°C and above, including mild days during the winter months, even when there is snow on the ground. This parasite is everywhere now, even in urban areas, like city parks and green spaces.

Ticks can spread Lyme Disease, Anaplasma and Ehrlichia. These diseases can cause serious illness in both pets and people.

Dogs and outdoor cats should be protected 12 months of the year because ticks are active in every month of the year.

Donor Criteria:

- Must be healthy and even-tempered
- Must weigh 25 kg (55 lbs) or more
- Must be between 1 to 8 years of age (18 months for giant breeds) to enter the program
- Must be up to date with vaccinations
- Must be receiving heartworm and tick preventative medications


Some of what we do:
